

TITLE I PART A SUPPLEMENT, NOT SUPPLANT TEST

In order to ensure Title I Part A Supplement, Not Supplant compliance, the West Central School District #49-7 will demonstrate that it allocates state and local funds to its schools in a manner that is neutral in regards to each school's Title I participation status.

The West Central school district will allocate state and local resources to its Title 1 Part A schools based on staffing and supplies, generally referred to as a "resource" based formula.

For purposes of the calculation the following assumptions will be used:

- actual principal compensation
- starting compensation for a new teacher in the district with no prior experience
- students to teacher ratio of 25:1
- supplies & materials costs per student of \$125.
- the Student Aid Fall Enrollment (SAFE) count.

The calculation for each building should go as follows:

- 1 principal x actual compensation = principal cost
- 1 guidance counselor x actual compensation = guidance counselor cost
- 1 librarian/district x actual compensation = librarian cost
- 25 students to 1 teacher x starting compensation for a new teacher with no prior experience = teacher cost
- Actual student count x \$125/student for supplies & materials = supplies & materials cost
- **Total of all costs = total required allocation of state and local resources to each building.**

The district uses the same method for all schools and maintains documentation of its method and calculations for auditing and monitoring purposes.
