

ADMINISTRATION IN POLICY ABSENCE

The superintendent may then take temporary action. However, the superintendent will not be free to act when the action involves a duty of the Board that by law cannot be delegated.

In each case in which the superintendent must take such action, he will present the matter to the Board for its consideration at its next meeting.
